The DAA is a coalition of member organizations, representing patient, professional and trade associations, other non-profit organizations, and corporations, all united in the desire to change the way diabetes is viewed and treated in America.

Since 2010, the DAA has worked to increase awareness of, and action on, the diabetes epidemic among legislators and policymakers. The twenty organizations that make-up the DAA share a common goal of elevating diabetes on the national agenda so we may ultimately defeat diabetes. In the United States, nearly 30 million Americans have diabetes and an additional 86 million have prediabetes placing them at high risk of developing the disease.
